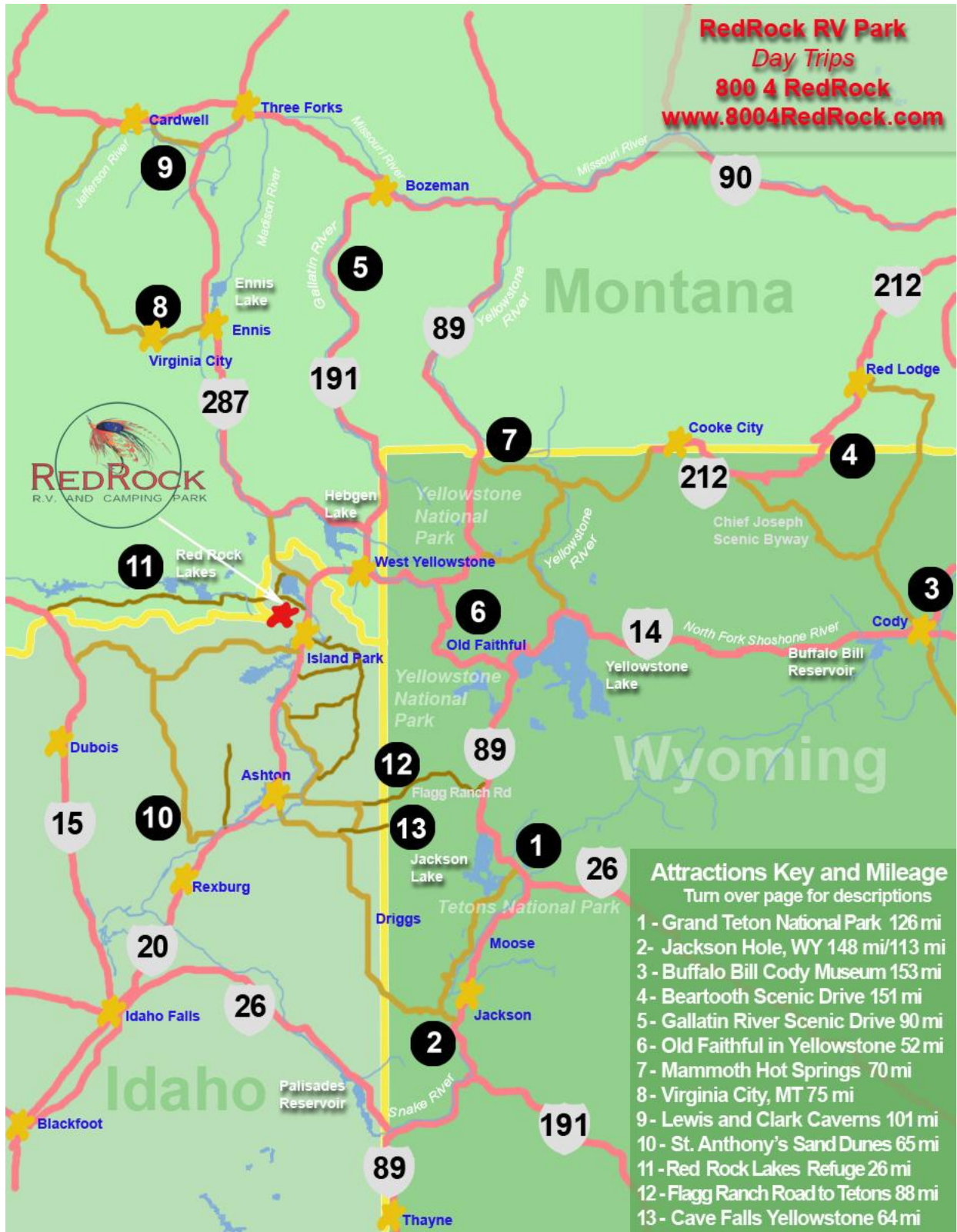

RedRock RV Park Day Trip Attractions Descriptions and Directions

See Map on reverse side of this page, or at <http://www.8004RedRock.com/map3.html>. Distances shown are one-way from the RedRock RV Park to the entrance of the destination. Unless otherwise stated, turn left out of the RedRock RV Park on Red Rock road and travel 5 miles East to the US20 intersection. Dirt roads may not be passable in wet conditions, but otherwise are not 4WD. Map and Descriptions **copyrighted** 2008 by RedRock RV Park, Island Park, Idaho. 800-473-3762

1. **Grand Teton National Park** – 126 mi, Turn left on US20 to Yellowstone West entrance. Turn right at Madison Jct and go thru YS park to Teton Park Entrance. Visit Lake Jenny, spectacular views of Tetons, and plenty of Moose, Elk, wildflowers. Fall is great time for aspens and maples. Fee. (free if already paid in Yellowstone National Park)
2. **Jackson Hole, WY** – 148 mi via Yellowstone Park, left on US20, thru YS park, right at Madison Jct, right at West Thumb jct, thru Tetons to Jackson. Consider returning south via 26 or through Driggs for Western Teton views. Shopping, Elk Refuge, scenic.
3. **Buffalo Bill Museums** – 153 mi, left on US20 to Yellowstone West Entrance, continue east at Madison Jct, right on Norris Cyn Rd, right at Canyon Jct and left at Lake Jct, follow hiway 14 to Cody. 720 Sheridan Ave. 6 great museums in one. Don't miss this if you have time. Fee.
4. **Beartooth Mtn Scenic Drive** – 151 mi, left on US20 thru YS Park, left at Madison Jct, right on Norris Cyn Rd, left at Canyon Jct on Grand Loop, right at Tower Jct on NE Entrance drive thru Hayden valley.. Take 212 from Cooke City to top. Beautiful alpine scenery at 11000 feet. Grizzly bears, black bears, mountain goats, bighorn sheep, elk, moose, wolverine, mountain lion and lynx are found here. Turnaround at Beartooth Pass. Fee in driving thru YS Park.
5. **Gallatin River Valley Scenic Drive** – 90 mi, left on US20, left on 191 in W. Yellowstone. Follow 191. Skirts side of YS Park. Beautiful river and rapids views. Narrow canyons. Schedule a raft trip, or go to Bozeman for shopping (CostCo). No Fee.
6. **Old Faithful Yellowstone** – 52 mi, left on US20 to W. Yellowstone, thru Park entrance to Madison Jct, then right to Old Faithful (follow signs). Geyser can be seen close to parking lot, but best to schedule a couple hours to walk around the entire Geyser basin. Fee.
7. **Mammoth Hot Springs** – 70 mi. left on US20, to W. Yellowstone, thru Park entrance to Madison Jct, then left. You might stop at Norris Geyser Basin & Artist's Paintpots on the way. Have lunch at Tower Jct. Consider coming back over Mount Washburn if open. Stop at Tower Falls. Beautiful thermal features, elk, bison, eagles, wildflowers. Fee.
8. **Virginia City MT** – 75 mi. right on Red Rock Rd, right at T in road to hiway 87, left at 87 to hiway 287, left at 287 to Ennis, MT. Continue on 287 west thru Ennis to Virginia City. Old frontier town worth seeing. Original bldgs, entertainment. Go 1 mi west to Nevada City too. No fee. Stop in Ennis for famous meat shop (Resvedt Meats).
9. **Lewis & Clark Caverns** – 101 mi, right out of RVPark around Henry's Lake, turn left at hiway 87, then left on hiway 287 north thru Ennis to hiway 2, then left following signs. Great stalactites, stalagmites, columns, and helicitites in limestone caverns near the Lewis & Clark Trail. State Park. Warm clothes & good shoes. L & C passed here on Jefferson River. Fee.
10. **St. Anthonys Sand Dunes**, 65 mi, right on US20 to exit 345 in St. Anthony's. Over US20 (west) to N. Bridge St. Turn left at W 4th N and continue on N. Parker then right (west) on N 2100E. Follow signs. Look for nature area to avoid ATVs. Nice dunes and elk herds.
11. **Red Rock Lakes Nat'l Wildlife Refuge** – 26 mi, decent dirt road. right on Red Rock Rd, left at T in road, to Refuge Sign. Drive another 10 miles to visitor center and then to lower lake. Serene, dramatic mtns, wildlife, wildflowers. Rare Trumpeter Swan. No Fee No services, take fuel, food, and water.
12. **Flagg Ranch Road to Tetons** – 88 mi, part dirt road. Right at US20, left at Mesa Falls Scenic Bypass (47), cross Warm River, left on E 1200 N which turns into Ashton-Flagg Ranch Rd. Scenic drive through forest, past lakes, a bit rough at the end, but passable by medium clearance vehicle. No fee. Back thru Yellowstone (fee).
13. **Cave Falls, Yellowstone** – 64 mi, part dirt. Right at US20, left at Mesa Falls Scenic Bypass (47), cross Warm River, left on E 1400 N and drive to end of road. Wide falls across Fall River, scenic, wildflowers. No fee.
